Municipal Enforcement Officer

Duties:

The Town of Wabush requires the services of a responsible individual to fill the position of Municipal Enforcement Officer. Municipal Enforcement Officers are employed for the preservation and maintenance of the public peace. They serve the public by responding to complaints relating to bylaw, traffic and animal control issues. They also serve the public through routine patrols, proactive measures and act as a liaison with the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary. This position will also entail responsibility with internal OH&S and will also act as lead hand with planning and permits within the Town.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate should possess the following qualifications:

- Possess a working knowledge of the justice system and a variety of municipal and provincial legislation.
- Minimum of 2 years related experience (i.e. Municipal Enforcement Officer, RCMP, RNC, other provincial/municipal police force or equivalent experience).
- Diploma in law enforcement, criminal justice or related field, however equivalent combination of education, training and experience may be considered.
- Certification in Occupational Health & Safety.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Acceptable Criminal Records Check and Drivers' Abstract.
- Valid Driver's License.
