3. Examine applications for development within the municipality to ensure that they conform to good engineering practices and principals and that they are compatible with existing municipal works and services.
4. Inspect, supervise, report on and make recommendations on the status of engineering investigations, construction projects and surveys.
5. Prepare itemized estimates of finances needed for the operation of his or her department and of capital sums required for municipal works, structures and equipment

Graduation from a recognized university or college with a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in civil, municipal or related engineering field and be licensed to practice as a professional engineer in the province of Newfoundland and Labrador.
